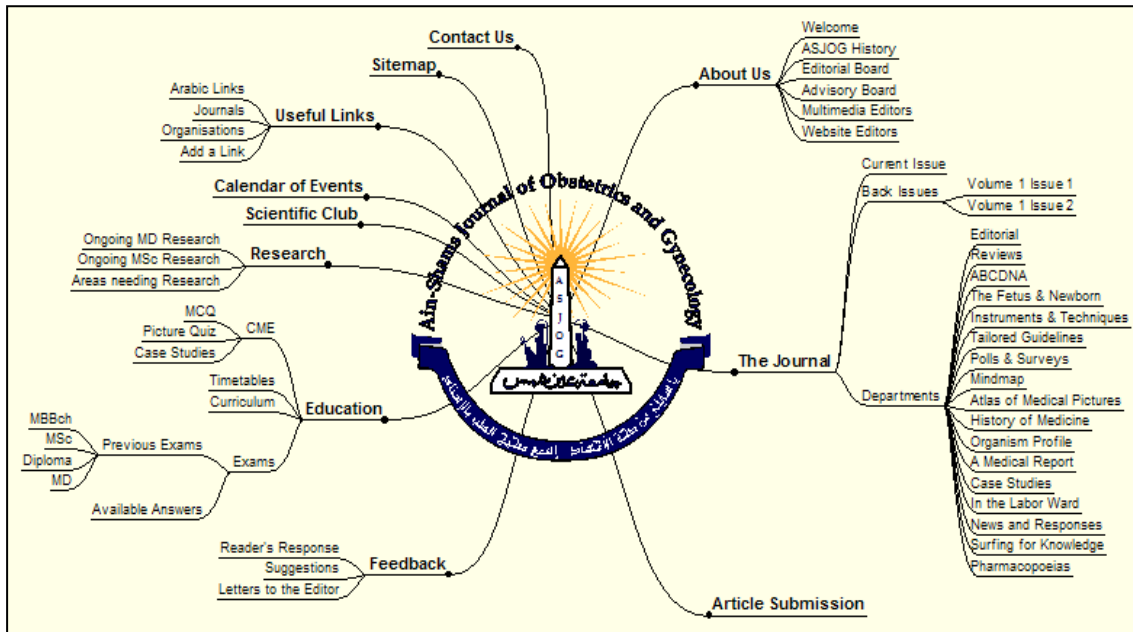




Surfing for Knowledge
